The local newspaper, The Fort Collins, Coloradoan, quoted Glen as stating, "As long as you are alive you can make choices to impact your life". He left the inmates with a message of encouragement to be all they can be once released.

The Program Unit at the Larimer County Detention Center brings in a guest speaker one time per month, throughout the year to provide the inmates an opportunity to hear other people's stories and offer them hope for success as they reintegrate into society.
